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#### a) External Bollards, Randlay Local Centre

Although a previous decision had agreed that £250.00 be offered to TWC, as 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of a project to provide an additional 5 bollards outside of the school and Centre to prevent parking, the recent accident has raised further concerns about the dangers faced daily by the children, parents and community centre users.

It was fortunate that no one was injured when the car rolled into Randlay Avenue having damaged bollards along its route.

It was therefore agreed that a meeting be requested, with representatives of TWC, RPS, Police and Parish Council, to return to discuss the Local Centre Safety Scheme.

# Councillor J Johnson declared an interest as attending a user group

### a) LED Internal Lights

The replacement lights have been installed and have been welcomed by user groups. A replacement emergency light was also required and fitted at the time when the service was off, this resulted in a cheaper quotation.

During the work, wasp nests were found in the loft and a specialist company was called in to dispose of them.

## b) SNAC

Further meetings will be required to discuss the future proposals for this group. In the meantime, we await delivery of the lock up in order that the building can be used.

## c) **Broadband**

We have already received notification of an increase in broadband costs for this new provision, currently this equates to £3 per month. If higher rates are received, we may have to consider an increase in charges to cover the cost.

#### d) WC Door Locks

We have experienced an issue with toilet locks being taken and leaving the doors unlockable. This will be monitored.

#### e) The Muddy

The PET team has been working to clear the areas around the site, back to the boundary fence and the result is excellent and much appreciate by local residents and users of the area.

A request for an extra litter and dog waste bin will be considered.
