TWC has confirmed that there will be 100% relief for the Rates for 2021/22 and discussions are continuing regarding re-opening up the car park in 2022/23.

NALC National Salary Increase

It has been confirmed that Local Government will receive a 1.75% increase, backdated to April 2021. The amount required will be added as an Earmarked Reserve.

Allotments

We are currently chasing outstanding payments.

The bench and shed are in place, and a picnic area with wild flowers will be created near to the gate.

New taps have been fitted and this has identified that some pipework will need upgrading. A quotation has been requested.

We are waiting for the quotation for the drainage work.

Safe Stronger Communities

A meeting has been arranged with a representative of TWC, this takes place on 23rd March. The launch has been arranged for 2nd April at The Sambrook Centre.
