E23/020 PARISH COUNCIL EVENT SHIRTS

It is important that Stewards are easily identifiable at Community Events. It is also Parish Council policy that staff and councillors are identified by their ID badges and Parish Council T-shirts.

Whilst we still have a number of shirts from previous years available, we do have a mixture of colours.

We now have new Members, Staff and Volunteers and it was considered that we should purchase a new set of shirts to be available for future events.

After a lengthy discussion, it was agreed that we would order the Royal Blue lightweight shirts, with the Parish Council logo (at a cost of £6.50).

All Councillors (and volunteers) are asked to confirm their size to the Clerk as soon as possible - this information must be received by Monday 10th July for the order to be included.

New Councillors or volunteers attending Fun Day on 2nd July will need to have one of the original T-shirts.

We have funding available in the Events Budget to cover the cost. It was proposed by Councillor Snell and seconded by Councillor S Unwin and this it is

RECOMMENDED that the Parish Council purchases a quantity of light-weight, royal blue polo shirts, with the PC logo, in various sizes, at a cost of £6.50 each.

We are now on countdown to the 15th Annual Fun Day on Hollinswood Pavilion Field. There is a fun-filled afternoon planned.

Copies of the proposed Field Layout were available and gave stewards an opportunity to have a vision of the layout of the field. It is important to know the location of the Information Stand – here there should always be a Parish Council Steward available. It is also important that stewards have adequate rest breaks, please ensure that the Information Point knows if you are leaving the site.
