YPP26/010 SNAC @ HARP

Following the report given to the Annual Parish Meeting, and having had discussions with families, it continues to be clear that there is a need for SNAC to continue to provide a Centre, with facilities and equipment to our SEND families at The Pavilion Building in Hollinswood. The Group is primarily for adults and is a meeting in a secure environment where there are common interests and friendship groups have become very important. Activities in the planning stages include Summer Event and traditional Christmas Event. SNAC continues to offer a placement to a student from Derwent College.

YPP26/011 YOUTH PROVISION

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YPP26/012 PARTNER REPORTS

a) Wednesday Wizards

Glyn Johnson, Wizards Leader, gave a report to Members stating that Wizards is in its 10th year and thanks to the support of Members of the YPP and Council, a wide range of activities are available free of charge as an afterschool club. From the 30 registered members, over 15 attend every week. Recent fund-raising raised an additional £28 and it is planned to hold a Sponsored Walk in the Summer.

b) 4 All Foundaion

George had sent his apologies, but hopes to attend the next meeting.

c) Nova Training

Claire from Nova Training had sent in a full report. Nova provides the Parish Council with volunteers and work groups in support of our projects and also in Randlay Valley. We currently have a work placement working with the LMT.

d) Barnardos

Stuart reported that this group is as popular as ever, with over 40 children attending on a Thursday night. The funding for this youth provision, which accepts referrals, ends in March 2027.

e) Love Play Active

Following the success of the Hollinswood Hub on a Friday night, a Monday night group has now started, for the younger members (up to 12).

YPP26/013 PAVILION FIELD

Liam and Stuart provided up to date information on the use of the field by local teams and also the details relating to the upcoming maintenance which is funded by the Football Foundation Grant.

YPP26/014 THE MUDDY

The current Working Group, Councillors Krajewski, Cranfield and Farrar, had met to discuss some initial ideas for the Muddy field. However, the drainage issue to the one end restricts what can be achieved.

The work to improve the drainage is going to be costly and the funding from TWC for initial works will be used to do further percolation and other tests prior to getting alternative quotations for the work.

In the meantime, consideration will be given to other work and minor enhancements that can be done within the current budget.

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Councillor S Unwin offered to join the working group.

When considering alternative options, members are keen that the parish council does not raise expectations as it is recognised that funding is limited and we need to ensure that any options included in consultation are achievable and that funding is available.

It is intended to hold a Winter Event at the Muddy, with the use of the slope and snow machine – details to be arranged.
