Parish Council Facilities

The Parish Council has various rooms for hire which are available for parties, meetings, groups, sports & social occasions.

We offer a bouncy castle package, that can be used either indoors or if the weather allows, outdoors at the Randlay Community Centre.

Recently both centres have been decorated and offer flexible room layouts for 5 to 125 people in a room, or if hiring the whole of Randlay 250! Ample free parking at each location is available along with kitchen facilities.

A hearing loop system will be installed in the coming months at Randlay, with options being looked at for both Hollinswood and The Pavilion. A new sound system will also be installed soon, along with a lighting rig in one of the halls.

We also have a sports field available for hire.

Parking in the Parish

Hollinswood & Randlay are suffering, along with many other local areas, with the effects of the additional cars that are now on our roads and consequently in our estates.

The Parish Council is working with Telford & Wrekin Council and the Police to address some of the serious local issues. There are some areas that are proposed for No Parking Zones and parking restrictions are to be added to other areas of our Parish.

In the meantime, please have respect for your neighbours and all our estates. When parking, please do not block anyone's drive or park on corners where you cause an obstruction or a visibility issue. Do not park in an alternative estate – you may not have a space in your road, near to your house, and this could be because someone from somewhere else has parked there. If everyone sticks to parking in their own street, maybe this can be a first step towards less frustration.

Consideration is being given to issues outside of the primary schools in order to keep the children safer. Please drive with care, particularly on Dale Acre Way and Randlay Avenue and always think – “there may be a child about to cross the road”.

Randlay Allotments

The area on Randlay Avenue known as Randlay Allotments is attended by many local gardeners, who use the plots to enable them to enjoy the outdoors whilst keeping fit and enjoying the fresh air.

This site is PRIVATE and not open to the public. Anyone found trespassing, will be reported to the authorities and relevant action taken. In order to keep the area more secure, we have employed the services of a local security company, which will patrol the site and report suspicious activity. Fortunately, this does not happen often, but we are working to put a stop to it completely.

We do have some plots available, if you are interested, please contact the Parish Council.
