Regeneration with the Parish

The Hollinswood Centre work has progressed at some rate in the past few months. The shops are fully open & the old building already demolished with the area nearly clear for the new car park. Further landscaping works will take place, especially focusing on the rear of the new shops & around the new Community Hub.

At Randlay, the Parish Council is in constant contact regarding the boarded area by the shops. This is now owned by the developer & we are awaiting future plans.

A feasibility study is taking place covering the parking area at The Local Centre, Randlay, to both improve access, traffic flow & safety - once this is completed the Council will consult requesting local views.
