Initial plans are being drawn up and we would like to extend to you, an invitation for you to attend an

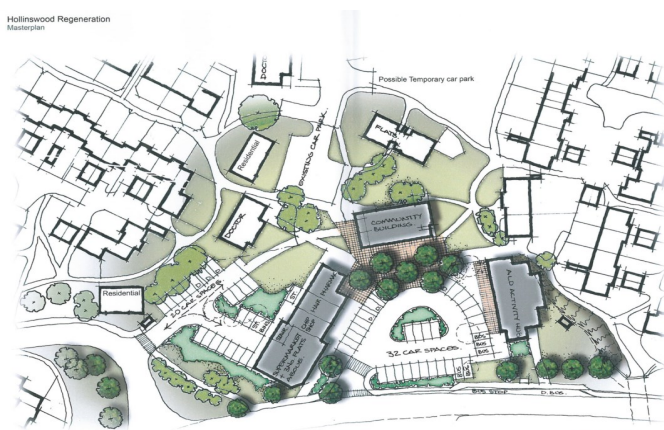

It has been a long term concern of the Parish Councillors that Hollinswood Local Centre is in need of improvement, upgrading and regeneration. This really is no surprise as the Centre is 40 years old, built for an earlier point in the community's development and has had limited investment since it was first constructed.

I am therefore pleased to announce that, after some years of working with Telford and Wrekin Council we have reached the point where we can present preliminary proposals for designs for the regeneration of Hollinswood Centre.

There will be a consultation event on Tuesday 16th September to be held at Hollinswood Neighbourhood Centre between 1.30 and 6.30pm.

I strongly recommend that you take the time to attend and use the opportunity to see the proposals, review them and the timescales, give your thoughts and recommendations and voice any concerns you have about the whole project.

Members of the Parish Council, Ward Councillors and officers will be there to listen to what you have to say.

The regeneration is to be carried out for the community in Hollinswood and it should be what you want it to be!

Also in the edition of our HARP newsletter, you are invited to join the Parish Council at other events in our calendar. Can I please draw your attention to the Macmillan Coffee Morning, Remembrance Day Service and our Christmas activities in particular?

From 10.30am on Sunday 9th November, we will parade from Meeting Point House to The Memorial in the Town Park to join in a service of remembrance. There will be hymns, readings and wreaths will be laid at the Memorial as part of the traditional service.

Over the years, we have promoted our Christmas Concert and Fayre and both events have been well attended. It is a pleasure to have the school children with us on these occasions. The Parish Council is providing fun and entertainment which includes free face-painting for every child and a clown will be sharing his circus skills with you.
